# 2024 APWA Fall Conference

## Four Person Best Shot

- In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by using the score on the low handicap hole and continuing as far as needed to break the tie.
- Course will assign tee numbers at check-in.
- Men younger than 65 play 3 holes each from blue tees, white tees, and gold tees on each 9. Can choose which holes to play from which tees.
- Men ages 65+ play from gold tees, women play from red tees.
- Threesomes rotate hitting a fourth ball on each shot
- 2 mulligan maximum per player
- Relief options for red penalty areas (formerly known as hazards) are to be used for lost balls and out of bounds. This is typically a drop with one stroke penalty at the spot the ball went out of bounds or is likely to be lost.
- Turn in scorecards to the pro shop immediately after your round.
- Please replace all divots, repair ball marks, and follow signs regarding carts.
- Flag Prize Holes and Flight Winner prizes are being finalized!
- Please pick up prize hole markers if you are the last group to play a hole.
