## Accessibility

### Q: Will the venues be accessible for delegates using wheelchairs?

A: Yes. The Orange County Convention Center and Rosen Centre are both fully accessible for individuals with mobility challenges.

# **Transportation**

### Q: Will local churches provide transportation?

A: No. UYC has secured centralized transportation for all official activities to ensure safety, consistency, and compliance with Risk Management protocols.

### Q: Can we use a 15-passenger van to transport our group?

A: Please follow your local conference's Risk Management guidelines regarding transportation.

### Q: Will BAYDA be providing transportation to and from the airport?

A: No. Delegates and Attendees must arrange their own transportation to and from the airport.

### Q: Is there transportation to Universal for all delegates?

A: Yes. Adequate transportation will be provided.

### Q: Can the buses accommodate car seats?

A: The bus company cannot guarantee that. The 3-point seatbelts that can be used to secure car seats is not standard across all coaches.

A: With respect to parking:

- Hotel: Please contact your hotel for current parking fees and policies, including for buses and personal vehicles.
- Convention Center: OCCC charges a parking fee of \$21.36 per car, per day. If you leave and come back, you will be charged again.
- Universal Islands of Adventure: Complementary parking after 6pm (address provided below in the Universal Studios section)


